

Selective demolition punch checklist

Selective demolition punch is where small misses become callbacks after the crew has demobilized. This checklist walks the finished work the way the owner and the next trade will see it, with the photo that closes each item instead of a note that reopens it. Work is commonly verified against the applicable building code, the project specifications. Confirm the edition your authority having jurisdiction has adopted.

Who runs it: The GC's superintendent closing demo punch items, often with the trade that inherited the area. When: During closeout of the area, once the follow-on trade has started and any hidden damage or over-cutting has surfaced.

Repair and protection

- ☐ **Over-demolition patched back to sound condition**
Any cutting past the limit line filled and made flush so the following finish sits flat, not just skimmed over. **2 photos required**
- ☐ **Protection removed cleanly**
Hoarding, floor protection and dust partitions taken down without marring the surfaces they were guarding. **1 photo required**

Documentation

- ☐ **Damage to adjacent work documented**
Any damage to work to remain photographed and logged against the area so responsibility is clear before signoff. **2 photos required**
