

Wall and corner protection punch checklist

Wall and corner protection punch is where small misses become callbacks after the crew has demobilized. This checklist walks the finished work the way the owner and the next trade will see it, with the photo that closes each item instead of a note that reopens it. Work is commonly verified against manufacturer's published instructions, the applicable building code. Confirm the edition your authority having jurisdiction has adopted.

Who runs it: The wall protection installer on a callback, or the GC's superintendent closing Division 10 punch items before turnover. When: During closeout, after corridors have seen cart and equipment traffic that reveals loose runs and knocked splices.

Defect repair

- ☐ Each loose or misaligned section located
A close shot of the condition plus a wide shot locating the run in the corridor or room, cause noted before rework. 2 photos required
- ☐ End caps, splices and color touch-up completed
End caps refitted, splices realigned, color and finish touch-up matched, section re-checked tight afterward. 2 photos required

Signoff

- ☐ No remaining protection items before the area is released
All punch items per corridor or room closed with photos, runs pull-checked once more before turnover. 1 photo required
